The Burnside Symphony Orchestra

The Burnside Orchestra, founded in 1956, is an amateur orchestra. It is supported by the City of Burnside Council and performs in aid of various charity organisations. Past conductors of the orchestra have been scientist John Black, flautist David Cubbin, violinists Robert Cooper, James Ferguson and Alphonse Anthony, oboist Bruce Stewart and cellist David Sharp. The orchestra's current conductor is Martin Butler.

Martin Butler

Martin Butler was born in London and began learning violin at the age of eight. When he was eleven Martin received a scholarship to the Guildhall School of Music. After leaving school he studied composition at Surrey University, graduating with a First Class Honours and Masters Degree. After a spell as a keyboard player in a rock band, Martin moved to Portugal where he played violin in the 'Teatro Nacional de Sao Carlos' in Lisbon. In Portugal he also pursued many other musical interests including ensemble, gypsy and jazz. During his last year in Portugal Martin began playing viola in the orchestra. In 1990 he joined the Adelaide Symphony Orchestra.

Peter Duggan

Born in Melbourne, but bred in Canberra, Peter Duggan graduated with a Bachelor of Music from the Canberra School of Music with majors in performance (studying oboe with David Nuttall) and musicology in 1991. He was then invited to attend the prestigious Pacific Music Festival where he played under several conductors including Neemi Jarvi, Christoph Eschenbach, and Michael Tilson-Thomas. Following this he pursued studies with the German oboist Jochen Mueller-Brincken in Wuerzburg. This led to several orchestral tours around many European countries and culminated in a six month contract with the Wuerzburg Philharmonic. Returning to Australia in 1995 Peter won a year's contract with the Adelaide Symphony Orchestra as principal Cor Anglais/section oboe, which became a permanent appointment one year later. While his duties with the ASO include playing principal oboe on occasion, Peter still finds time for his real passions – guitar, hiking, playing sport and Collingwood.
