

BOUQUET FROM KRIPS

The SA Symphony Orchestra conductor (Henry Krips) this week praised the new City of Burnside Symphony Orchestra.

He heard the orchestra's performance in Burnside Town Hall on August 12.

He said: "Already I consider it to be the finest amateur body of its kind in Adelaide.

"The conductor, Dr. John Black, is a most gifted person. The orchestra is very fortunate in its choice of him as a conductor. I feel it will reach a very high standard under him."

Mr. Krips said the programme was well chosen. The decision to perform two symphonies on the one programme immediately put the orchestra just a little higher than

other similar bodies in Adelaide.

"The people of Burnside should be solidly behind this orchestra," Mr. Krips added.
