Given its first performance in 1808 at the same concert as the first performance of the sixth symphony (but strangely enough in the second half of the programme). Beethoven's Fifth has always had a powerful emotional appeal.

Legend has it that on first hearing this symphony the famous singer Malibran was seized with convulsions and had to be carried from the hall. Another story relates that a veteran in Napoleon's Old Guard, on hearing the famous C major entry of the finale, sprang to his feet exclaiming "C'est l'Empereur"...

During the War the opening four notes in the rhythm of the letter "V" in the Morse Code became a symbol of Victory to many people. Beethoven said of them "Thus Fate knocks at the door".

Let the music speak for itself. It remains one of the musical masterpieces of all time.
