SOLOIST: BOGDAN KAZIMIERCZAK

Violinist BOGDAN KAZIMIERCZAK is currently a lecturer in music for the Dept. of Technical and Further Education.

Born in Łódź, Poland, he was already learning violin when, as nine-year--old, he migrated to Australia with his family and settled in Adelaide.

He was accepted as a pupil of Ladislav Jasek, the Czech violinist on the staff of the Elder Conservatorium, University of Adelaide. He won a series of scholarships, the last of them to study overseas, at the Royal College of Music. His principal tutor at the R.C.M was Jose Garcia, celebrated leader of the English Chamber Orchestra.

On his return from the Royal Col-

lege of Music /London/, where he studied as an Elder Overseas Scholarship Scholar, he completed his Master's Degree in performance at the University of Adelaide.

He spent seven years in the Adelaide Symphony Orchestra, the last three of which as associate concertmaster. During that time he had frequent ABC engagements as soloist, chamber music player /with the Adelaide String Quartet/ and as a recording artist. He is founder of a chamber orchestra which has broadcast for the ABC and has been engaged for the Adelaide Festival of Arts.

His forthcoming engagements include recitals at the Flinders University and Festival Theatre Foyer Concerts.
