The Burnside Symphony Orchestra

The Burnside Orchestra, founded in 1956, is an amateur orchestra. It is supported by the City of Burnside Council and performs in aid of various charity organisations. Past conductors of the orchestra have been scientist John Black, flautist David Cubbin, violinists Robert Cooper, James Ferguson and Alphonse Anthony, oboist Bruce Stewart and cellist David Sharp.

The orchestra's current conductor is Martin Butler.

Martin Butler

Martin Butler was born in London and began learning violin at the age of eight. When he was eleven Martin received a scholarship to the Guildhall School of Music. After leaving school he studied composition at Surrey University, graduating with a First Class Honours and Masters Degree. After a spell as a keyboard player in a rock band, Martin moved to Portugal where he played violin in the 'Teatro Nacional de Sao Carlos' in Lisbon. In Portugal he also pursued many other musical interests including ensemble, gypsy and jazz. During his last year in Portugal Martin began playing viola in the orchestra. In 1990 he joined the Adelaide Symphony Orchestra.

Harley Gray

Harley was born in Sydney in 1977. Taking up the bass at the age of 10 it soon became clear that Harley was destined for a life at the rear of the orchestra. Moving to England in 1989, he spent the next ten or so years honing his skills within various youth orchestras, culminating in acceptance into the National Youth Orchestra of Great Britain and the Guildhall School of Music. At the Guildhall he studied under Tom Martin and Kevin Rundell, all the while developing a keen passion for the music of Bottesini. In 1999, Harley took up a position with the Adelaide Symphony Orchestra, and plans to record a CD of Bottesini's music in the near future.
