The orchestra's present conductor is Alphonse Anthony. Alphonse Anthony studied under the Israeli Conductor Shalom Ronli-Riklis and has conducted in Singapore and Tasmania before coming to Adelaide. Apart from being a member of the Tasmanian Symphony Orchestra, he was also choirmaster of St. Mary's Orchestra from 1972 - 75. Alphonse Anthony has been a member of the Adelaide Symphony Orchestra since 1976.
